Directions for Preparing an Aerial of Your Property

- 1) Log onto <http://giswww.westchestergov.com/gismap>
- 2) Enter your property address on right hand side of screen
- 3) Under Search for Location, Select **Go**
- 4) Under the tools bar menu click on the **Add Map Service** icon
- 5) Select **Tax Parcel Boundaries**
- 6) On **Aerial Scale**, Select 2013
- 7) Once aerial map is displayed, print a copy
- 8) On the aerial map, clearly draw the boundaries of agricultural, farm woodland and nonagricultural areas

Agricultural: All land used in agricultural production as defined in §301.4 of Agricultural Districts Law (<http://www.agriculture.ny.gov/AP/agsservices/25-AA.pdf>). This may include fallow lands.

Farm Woodland: Up to 50 acres of land per parcel meeting the definition of farm woodland per §301.3 of Agricultural Districts Law (<http://www.agriculture.ny.gov/AP/agsservices/25-AA.pdf>), which is land used for the production for sale of woodland products.

Non-Agricultural: All remaining land not used in agricultural production or as farm woodland, such as land used for residential purposes, including residences, garages, other accessory buildings and land associated with residences, and land used for processing or retail merchandising.

Note: Waterbodies will be included with their surrounding or adjacent land uses.
